## DACBSP® EXAM DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS

The ACBSP™ is in need of individuals who are interested in helping with the development of the DACBSP® written examination. Individuals who volunteer to help will review previously written questions, set item difficulty values for the items, as well as write new items for the examinations. Individuals who participate in these workshops must have their DACBSP® certification and be in good standing with the ACBSP, but no other special training or certification is required. All training for the tasks performed will be provided at the workshop.

Interested individuals should submit their name and a brief resume along with their Symposium registration form. ACBSP continuing education credits are offered, along with a 50% discount on the Symposium registration fee. DACBSP® participants are asked to commit to an 8-hour workshop on Thursday and/or a 4-hour workshop on Friday morning. All discussions will be confidential and participants must adhere to standards of confidentiality with all information discussed. All individuals who have their DACBSP® certification are encouraged to sign up.

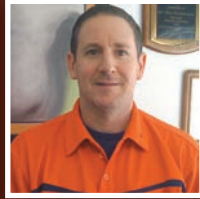

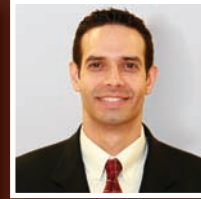

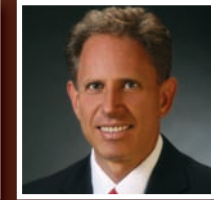
